- Be a member of SHEA.

To apply for the SHEA scholarship, please provide the following information:

- Resume and cover letter highlighting your commitment to supporting and enhancing the physical, emotional, mental and spiritual wellbeing of children and/or youth and to championing high quality health education in school communities.
- An official transcript

Applicants are invited to include one letter of reference to support their application.
