

SHEA Constitution (June, 2014)

Article 1: NAME

The name of the organization shall be the Saskatchewan Health Educators Association (SHEA).

Article 2: AFFILIATION

The council shall be affiliated with the Saskatchewan Teachers' Federation as a special subject council.

Article 3: OBJECTIVES

The objectives of the SHEA shall be:

(a) To support and enhance professional growth of members regarding provincial health education curricula, developmentally appropriate health information and resources, and comprehensive school community health approaches to well-being.

(b) To offer advice and recommendations to the provincial executive and its committees, (e.g., SSC Coordinating Committee) on matters affecting health education and comprehensive school community health.

Article 4: MEMBERSHIP

Those eligible for membership are:

(a) All Federation members as defined in Federation Policy 2.7.2(2).

(b) Any other person with a professional interest in health education.

Article 5: FEES

Membership fees shall be established by resolution at the annual meeting of the special subject council.

Article 6: OFFICERS' ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

The officers of SHEA shall include:

- President/Privacy Chair
- Vice president
- Past president
- Treasurer
- Secretary
- Website Manager
- Awards and Scholarship Coordinator
- Communications Coordinator
- University Liaison
- Ministry of Education Liaison
- Ministry of Health Liaison
- No fewer than 4 and no more than 7 Members at Large

These officers shall fulfill their respective roles as described on the SHEA website, www.sheaonline.ca. All officers who are current members of SHEA shall be voting members. Officers shall be elected at the annual meeting, with the exception of the past president.

Article 7: ANNUAL MEETING

The annual meeting shall be held at such time and place as determined by the executive of the council.

Article 8: REPRESENTATION

Any representation which SHEA wishes to make to any organization, persons, government, department or other agency outside the Federation shall be conducted through the regular channels of the Federation as provided under section 36 in *The Teachers' Federation Act, 2006*.

Article 9: AMENDMENTS

After notice of motion to amend the constitution has been given, amendment may be effected by a two-thirds vote of members present at an annual meeting.

Article 10: DISSOLUTION AND DISBURSEMENT

Dissolution of a council shall be affected by a two-thirds vote of members present at an annual meeting. In case of dissolution of the SHEA, remaining assets will be disbursed to the Saskatchewan Teachers' Federation.
